<b>A = 4</b>	<b>93-100</b>	11-12
<b>B = 3</b>	<b>85-92</b>	8-10
<b>C = 2</b>	<b>75-84</b>	5-7
<b>D = 1</b>	<b>67-74</b>	2-4
<b>F = 0</b>	<b>0-66</b>	0-1

- To determine the final grade for the year's work, use the scale for total points for three grading periods. The student must have a total of two (2) points in order to pass the course.
- Attendance is not being considered for student retention due to the waiver from the Governor.
- Social Studies for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades should be completed. Science-students will get their 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks grade.

**\*\* Middle School Students & High School Credit**

**Many middle school students were enrolled in courses that offered an opportunity to earn a high school credit. Those students will receive the credit for courses they were enrolled in if they meet all pupil progression requirements. Students that were NOT enrolled in a class, but planned to take a proficiency exam to earn a credit will not be afforded that opportunity. Any 8<sup>th</sup> grade student who obtains 2 quality points in ELA or Math will promoted as a T9 student.**
