As we approach August 11th, we want to assure you that we are excited to welcome your children to our campuses. They are, and always will be, our primary focus. We ask that you remember our number one priority is the safety, health and well-being of your child, our staff, and our community. Facial coverings are optional for adults and students.



Buses, classrooms, and high touch surfaces will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected daily including the restrooms.



LPPS asks that all employees and students consider the COVID-19 vaccination. LPPS believes this vaccination decision rest between the individual and his or her medical provider; therefore, we ask that all individuals consult with their medical provider.

If a person tests positive for COVID-19 (isolate)

- Stay home for 5 days; if the person has no symptoms or the symptoms are resolving after five days, the person can return on day 6.
- If the person has a fever, continue to stay home until fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicines (Tylenol or Ibuprofen).
- The person should continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. If the mask is not worn for 5 additional days, then the person should isolate for a full 10 days.



Schools are encouraged to maintain static groups to the maximum extent possible if the school is experiencing an increase in COVID-19 cases.



LPPS will adhere to reporting weekly aggregate case counts and core group outbreaks to the LDH COVID-19 Reporting Portal.
